Have fun with the weather

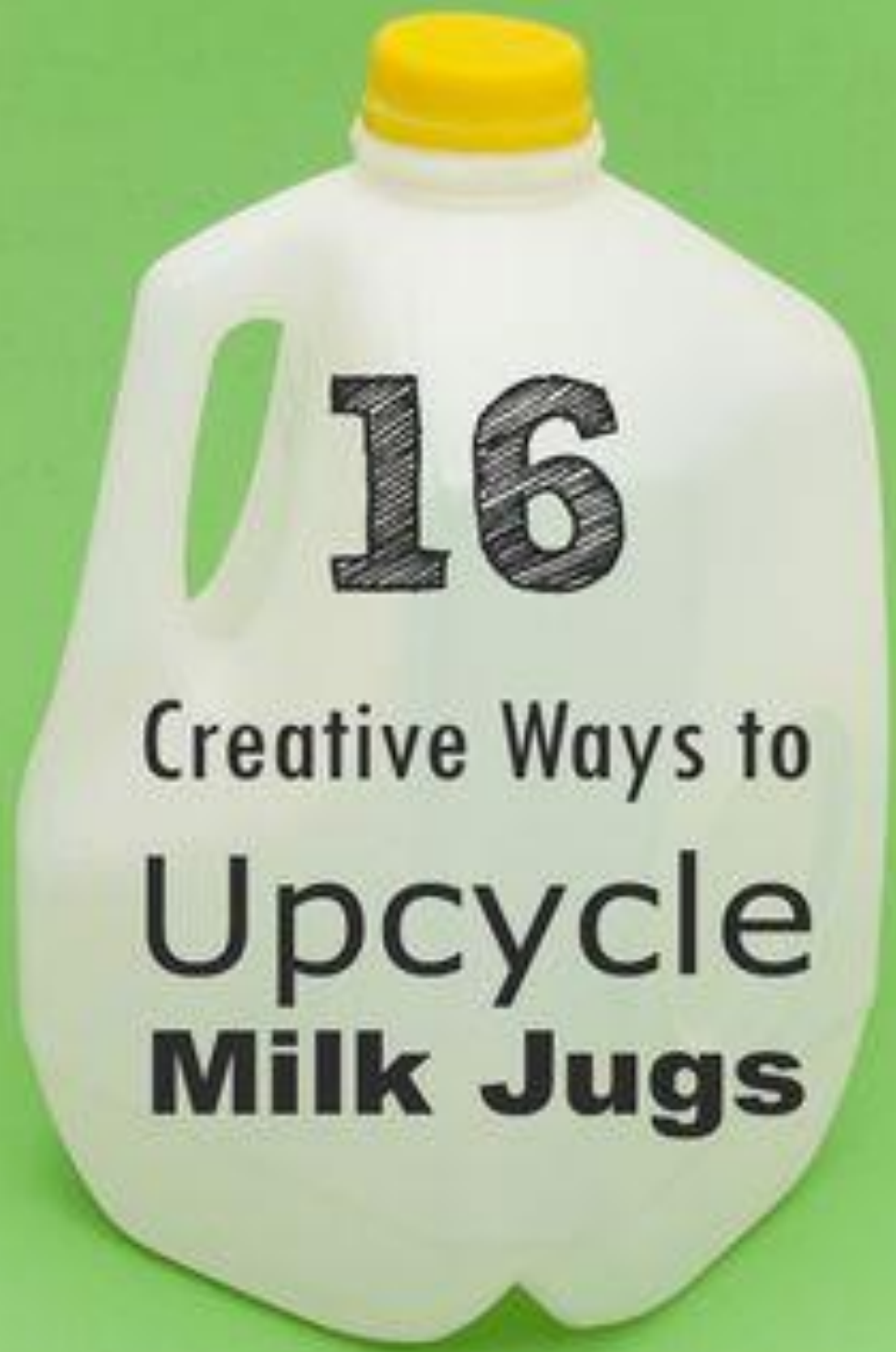
Milk jugs can be used as a rain saver or a wind sock. These items are easy to create using common household tools.
